Respected Sir/Ma'am,

Sub: Release of funds under SBM (U) FY 2016-17

As you may be aware, the Ministry of Urban Development (MoUD) is taking numerous steps to improve the sanitation and solid waste management situation in the country so that the objectives of the Swachh Bharat Mission are met by 2019.

- 2. For FY 2016-17, Rs 2300 crores has been allotted to expenditure towards various components of the Swachh Bharat Mission including Individual Household Latrines, Community Toilets, Solid Waste Management and IEC & Capacity Building. The state-wise and component-wise breakup of this budget and physical targets for the year 2016-17 is at Annexure I and II respectively.
- In April 2016, fund release have not happened as per schedule due to a various issues. I would request you to direct the concerned to follow the SBM guidelines while seeking funds from MoUD, a short note on special issues to be taken care of for this year's funds release is appended at Annexure III.
- I request you to kindly hold meetings of the High Powered Committee (HPC) every week, so that the maximum number of proposals can be taken up and approved before 17th May 2016. Following the same, proposals for fund release may kindly be sent to MoUD latest by 19th May, so that we can process the release within the month of May itself. It is my belief that this will go a long way in sustaining the momentum achieved in Swachh Bharat mission.

Procedure for release of funds under SBM (U) for FY 2016-17

1) Individual Household Latrines

- a. For the funds released (for first instalment) in FY 2014-15, Utilization Certificates (UC) has to be submitted in order for the release for FY 2016-17 to be processed.
- b. Against the money received from GoI, states should have released money to ULBs. Document which details states' share release is also to be submitted.
- c. Partial UC (for FY 2014-15) shall also be acceptable, in which case the unutilized amount will be adjusted against the release for FY 2016-17.

2) Community Toilets

- a. For the funds released (for first instalment) in FY 2014-15, Utilization Certificates (UC) has to be submitted in order for the release for FY 2016-17 to be processed.
- b. Against the money received from Gol, states should have released money to ULBs. Document which details states' share release is also to be submitted.
- c. Partial UC (for FY 2014-15) shall not be acceptable, and a minimum 75% physical and financial progress is to be demonstrated.

3) Solid Waste Management

- a. For the funds released (for first instalment) in FY 2014-15, Utilization Certificates (UC) has to be submitted in order for the release for FY 2016-17 to be processed.
- b. In case of underutilization of FY 2014-15 funds (<75%), the underutilized amount will be adjusted against the release for FY 2016-17.

4) IEC and Capacity Building

a. For the funds released in FY 2014-15 and FY 2015-16, Utilization Certificates (UC) for minimum 75% utilization has to be submitted in order for the release for FY 2016-17 to be processed. Furthermore, the Annual Action Plan for FY 2016-17 has also to be submitted.
