Dear Sir,

As you are aware, Ministry of Urban Development is implementing Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) Urban with a goal to make the country clean and open defecation free by 2nd October 2019.

- 2. ODF declaration is a two-step process which starts with Self-Declaration of Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) as ODF. The self-declaration is then verified by Quality Council of India(QCI) as third party verification.
- 3. QCI has been commissioned by the ministry to conduct the Third Party Inspection (TPI) to certify a ULB ODF. The mandate for this project is to inspect 4,041 towns/cities of India and assess if the city/town can be declared as ODF.
- 4. Hence, the certificate and/or report issued by QCI in regard to the ODF declaration of a city/town should be treated as the final declaration. This certificate will remain valid for six months from the date of issue.

I look forward to your cooperation in making this process a success to make all 4,041 cities ODF before 2nd October, 2019.
