Please refer to my earlier D.O. letter of even number dated 6^{th} July ,2015,in which it had been informed that this Ministry had entered into an MoU with M/s CSC e-Governance Services India ltd.to undertake the task of online filling up of IHHL application form of citizens/ULBs, through its common services centers across the country .

2. It was envisaged that transaction fee will be payable in two phases in the following manner:

phase	Work done by CSCs	Fees Payable(Rs.)
Phase 1	Complete filling of application form with beneficiary's photo upload and uploading of scanned photo of passbook	15
Phase 2	ase 2 1 geo tagged photograph uploading for final work.	

The above was derived on the presumption that toilets will be built by individuals. But during video conferences and interaction with States it has transpired that a number of ULBs/municipalities are constructing toilets through bulk construction contracts by contractor or NGOs. In such cases since no amount is transferred into beneficiary individual's account, it is not required to capture and upload passbook detail of individual. We have, accordingly, modified the software where passbook details of such cases will not be shown.

3. In the changed format now payment for CSCs will be in three phases in following manner:

Phase	se Work done by CSCs	
Phase1	Complete filling of application form with beneficiary's photo upload.	10
Phase 2	se 2 Scanned copy of individual's passbook upload.	
Phase 3	Phase 3 1 geo tagged photograph upload for final work.	

- 4. In view of the above, henceforth, the cases will be of two categories as detailed below:
 - a) Wherever toilets are constructed by individuals, payment being made to M/s CSC will be Rs.15/- + Rs.5/- i.e. Rs.20/-
 - b) Wherever toilets are constructed by ULBs by bulk construction contracts and NGOs, payment will be Rs.15/- only.
