Sub: Identification of bulk waste generators and purchase of decentralized composting machines by them

Dear Sir/Ma'am,

As you are aware, the Solid Waste Management Rules 2016 require bulk waste generators, i.e. establishments that generate more than 100 kgs of waste per day, to segregate their waste at source and process, treat and dispose of biodegradable waste within premises to the extent possible, through composting or bio-methanation.

- 2. In view of this, the next Swachh Survekshan will take into cognizance the number of bulk waste generators in each city, as well as whether they are segregating their waste and composting the biodegradable component of that waste.
- 3. In order to ensure a good score in this area as well as to facilitate compliance with the specified rules, you are requested to identify and enumerate all bulk waste generators in your city and encourage them to purchase decentralized composting machines.
