

## **Enrolment of Indian and Global solution providers for scientific management of Municipal Solid Waste under Swachh Bharat Mission**

Under the Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM), Govt. of India has targeted to achieve collection, transportation, processing & disposal of MSW in a scientific manner in 4041 cities/towns of India by 2019. Accordingly, it is planned to enrol solution providers offering diverse technology options both from India and abroad for scientific management of MSW under the Swachh Bharat Mission.

The data bank of technologies for municipal solid waste management would enable local bodies take informed decision on technology choices.
