You are aware that the Government of India has launched "Swachh Bharat Mission" (SBM) on 2nd October, 2014 with a target to make the country clean by 2nd October, 2019. The Mission covers all 4041 statutory cities and towns as per census 2011 and the components eligible under SBM with broad funding pattern are (i) Household Toilet - Rs.4000 per toilet as an incentive; (ii) Community Toilet – max. 40% VGF; (iii) Public toilets - 100% private investment; and (iv) Solid Waste Management Project – max. 20% VGF. The projects will be implemented involving substantial private sector investment, contribution from beneficiaries and Government incentive/support for viability gap funding (VGF).

2 The scheme guidelines are presently under finalisation and would be communicated shortly. Draft guidelines are available on Ministry's website www.moud.gov.in and may be referred to for comments/preparation of implementation plan. In the meantime, you are requested to prepare an action plan for achieving the target of "Swachh Bharat Mission" (SBM) within five years period (with year wise breakup) in respect of soft and physical components of the Mission. Also, all ULBs may be directed to prepare Plan for construction of public toilets/community toilets as well as solid waste management, on PPP basis and requisite land may be identified and possession taken at earliest possible. Further, to ensure that the programme is smoothly implemented, State Government may like to use a website/IT platform where all beneficiaries can send the request online seeking Government grant/incentive for the construction of household toilets in the indicative **Format I** enclosed.
