As you are aware, one of the key components of the Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban), being implemented by Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) is to monitor the progress of cities in the mission implementation. Swachh Survekshan, conducted by MoHUA, is one of the monitoring tools used to assess the performance of cities on various parameters. After the success of Swachh Survekshan 2016 and 2017, Swachh Survekshan 2018 will be the largest ever Swachh survey in the world covering 40 crore people and all 4041 Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) of India.

2. In Swachh Survekshan-2018, to be started on 4<sup>th</sup> January 2018, MoHUA has also planned to cover and assess all 62 Cantonment Boards in India.

3. In order to keep Cantonment Boards updated on the Swachh Survekshan components/indicators and to address their queries, a half-day workshop is scheduled on **14<sup>th</sup> December, 2017 at New Delhi.**

Delhi Cantonment Board may also invite other officers/employees engaged in Swachh Bharat Mission activities. Shri Anil Prakash, Swachh Survekshan Expert from MoHUA will conduct the workshop.
