Subject: Expediting Aadhaar Seeding in IHHL Applications

Sir/Ma'am,

As you are aware that Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban) 1.0 is going to end by 31st March 2021 and Aadhaar Seeding of IHHL Beneficiaries is one of the parameters where States/UTs are still lagging. Please refer to this Ministry's OM dated 27th November 2018 regarding 'Use of Aadhaar in DBT Schemes (SBM-U)- Judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court' (Annexure-A, as per attachment) requesting States/UTs and ULBs to ensure that all Individual Household Applicants possess Aadhaar or enrollment slip for Aadhaar as required under Section 7 of the Aadhaar Act 2016.

2. It is to draw your kind attention on the status of Aadhaar seeding at National level. Out of 59.62 lakh IHHL applications approved till date, 6% of applications have Aadhaar Numbers but they are not seeded (verified) and 18% of applications are still without Aadhaar. State-wise Aadhaar Seeding status is enclosed in Annexure B(as per attachment). Although, this issue has been raised during regular meetings and video conferences conducted with the states, the progress has been very slow. The following table highlights the status:

3. In view of the above, I request your personal intervention to ensure 100% Aadhaar Seeding of eligible Individual Household Toilet beneficiaries of your State/UT, in line with the aim of Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban). It is also suggested to involve local NGOs, SHGs, Asha Workers among others to collect the Aadhaar details from beneficiaries to speed up the process on incentive/honorarium basis with the approval of SHPC.

Looking forward to your immediate action in this regard.

Subject: Use of Aadhaar in DBT Schemes (SBM-U) - Judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Hon'ble Supreme Court in its judgement delivered on 26th September, 2018 on Aadhaar has upheld the validity of Section 7 of the Aadhaar Act, 2016 which states that:

" The Central Government or, as the case may be, the State Government may, for the purpose of establishing identity of an individual as a condition for receipt of a subsidy, benefit or service for which the expenditure is incurred from, or the receipt there from forms part of, the Consolidated Fund of India, require that such individual undergo authentication, or furnish proof of possession of Aadhaar number or in the case of an individual to whom no Aadhaar number has been assigned, such individual makes an application for enrolment:

Provided that if an Aadhaar number is not assigned to an individual, the individual shall be offered alternate and viable means of identification for delivery of the subsidy, benefit or service".

In this regard, States and ULBs are requested to ensure that all Individual Household Toilet Applicants under Swachh Bharat Mission should possess Aadhaar or enrolment slip for Aadhaar, while adhering to Section 7 of the Aadhaar Act 2016 (Issued OM enclosed for reference as Annexure)
