MoUD Conducts Workshop For Small and Medium Industries, Under Swachh Bharat Mission

New Delhi | May 14, 2016: In wake of the cleanliness fortnight directed towards Industries, the Ministry of Urban Development (MoUD) conducted an interactive workshop at Wazirpur Industrial Estate, to help effect an interface between the Municipal Administration, the regulatory bodies and the small and medium Industrial bodies. The workshop, attended by management representatives of all 11 Industrial Estates of Delhi State, DSIIIDC and various Citizen Groups, was addressed by Shri Saurav Jain, Additional Mission Director, Swachh Bharat Mission, MoUD, Shri Rohit Kakkar, Joint Advisor, CPHEEO, MoUD, as well as Member Secretaries of Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), and Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC).
