AGREEMENT ON COMPOST MARKETING

New Delhi: In a first-of-its-kind agreement, IL&FS Environmental Infrastructure & Services Limited, National Fertilizers Limited and South Delhi Municipal Corporation have entered an arrangement for the marketing of city compost produced in the capital. The agreement facilitated by the Ministry of Urban Development (MoUD) comes on the back of the Union Cabinet decision early January on the promotion of city compost, wherein a market development assistance of ₹1500 per metric tonne of city compost would be paid to the fertilizer marketing companies.
