## Swachh Bharat Mission: Center Holds Training For State NIC Teams For Smooth Implementation Of MIS Application

**New Delhi, 8 February 2016**: The Ministry of Urban Development held a training session with all State Information Officers (SIOs) of the different State Informatics Center representatives from across the country on the proper functioning of Swachh Bharat Mission MIS application. For real time information management of Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban), the National Informatics Center (NIC) has developed a Swachh Bharat Mission MIS application which is being used by various stakeholders to update, review and monitor the progress of Swachh Bharat Mission across India.

The discussion broadly revolved around overall understanding of SBM MIS portal and associated Swachh Bharat Mission activities. The Swachh Bharat Mission MIS application is being used by Urban Local Bodies and states/UTs of 4041 Statutory town & cities across India to enter, verify & approve the details of Individual Household Latrines, upload photographs of commenced & constructed Community and Public Toilets, uploading 'swachh city plans' and activities / photographs around Sanitation Intensive drives, etc. covered under Swachh Bharat Mission. Given the criticality of the Swachh Bharat Mission and high transactional traffic on the SBM MIS application, Ministry of Urban Development has requested NIC team at States and Districts level to handhold the SBM State Mission Directorates and Urban Local Bodies for regular updation of data, verification & approval processes on SBM MIS application

The knowledge session for all State Informatics Officers of NIC on SBM MIS application was organized at the Ministry of Urban Development on 1<sup>st</sup> of February. The SIOs, at the end of the session, were directed to hold a similar training session with the Swachh Bharat Mission State Directorates, all District Informatics Officers (DIOs) & State Coordinators to ensure the smooth implementation of Swachh Bharat Mission MIS application in their respective states, by 5<sup>th</sup> February 2016. Thereafter, all District Information Officers from NIC are expected to provide training on SBM MIS application to District Collectors, Urban Local Bodies officials and CSC coordinators at district level by 10<sup>th</sup> February 2016.
