It is located at 16.58°6488N 74.306287°E. It is a C class Municipal Council and it is situated on National Highway 4. Council was established in the year 1901; it is located at boundary of Maharashtra and Karnataka which is 20 km from historic city and tourism place Kolhapur. Has been traditionally, an agriculture based place.

Primarily, remains an agricultural activity based city, thus rural type profile is predominant. Urban development happened due to large scale Manufacturing industry and processing unit. As per 2011 census the total city area is 29 Sq.KM and the population is 34106 of which 17634 Males while 16472 are females as per Census India 2011. Projected population for 2017 is 42000 and 48000 in 2018. The density of population in the city in these years is 1581 and 1650 persons per sq.km respectively. Covered By residential and other buildings and amenities rest of area is agricultural land. I.e. area of focus is 29 Sq.KM. a number of properties, counted in the city is 9500. Overall area of the city is 29 Sq. K.M. In the city, the length of firm roads is 53 K.M. & gutters length is 43 K.M.


