100% door to door collection of 100% source segregated waste (Wet, Dry and Domestic Hazardous Waste)

100% scientific management of all fractions of waste, including safe disposal in scientific landfills



Remediation of legacy dumpsites and conversion into green zones

Safe treatment of used water, including fecal sludge, especially in smaller cities

Focus on phased reduction in usage of Single-Use Plastic (SUP)
