**Sub: Release of Mobile App for Loading of Geotagged Photos on SBM Portal.**

As you are aware that Swachh Bharat Mission is the flagship programme of the Government of India. Its success depends on ground level execution of various SBM components as well as visibility of the same on Swachh Bharat Mission portal <http://swachhbharaturban.gov.in>.

In order to facilitate loading of Geotagged Photos on Swachh Bharat Mission components on the URL <http://swachhbharaturban.gov.in> a mobile app has been developed to transfer Geotagged photos of all the four components Individual HouseHold Latrines (IHHL), Community Toilets (CT), Public Toilets (PT) & Solid Waste Management (SWM) directly to the server. The salient features of the mobile app are given below.

- The .apk file for the mobile app can be downloaded on the mobile directly from the site URL <http://msbmurban.gov.in>
- The URL <http://msbmurban.gov.in> also has the required user manual & FAQs etc. for ready reference.
- The .apk file facilitates any citizen registered with Swachh Bharat urban portal to upload Geotagged IHHL photos for both Commenced & Constructed toilets by their Application Id, as was available in web portal.
- It also facilitates Ward Verifiers/ Nodal Officers of the ULBs to upload Geotagged photos on any of the four components i.e IHHL / CT/ PT & SWM under heads Collection/ Transportation/ Processing & Disposal, provided there exist a record for each of these components on the web portal.
- The mobileapp is in Android version and requires the Mobile number as well as the LoginId of the user on [swachhbharaturban.gov.in](http://swachhbharaturban.gov.in) portal for authentication.
